Alaska Drivers License Renewal Requirements

- – Class A, B, C licenses are designated for commercial drivers of commercial motor vehicles.. Not all DMV procedures can be completed at every location Additionally, note that wait times are typically lengthy..
- Pass a vision screening Types of Drivers Licenses in Alaska Alaska driving licenses are available to residents who meet age and other qualifications set by the AK Division of Motor Vehicles..
- Provide the appropriate documentation
- Pass the written drivers test and the road test, if applicable.. The road skills requirement is waived and residents instead submit their application materials to the Alaska DMV by mail.. However, before visiting a local branch, be sure to verify that the location offers the service you require.. To secure a license to drive, residents need to meet the minimum age qualification and visit an AK DMV office to present documents that prove their identity, legal presence in the United States and in-state residency.. Property must have a valid Alaska driver's license or permit Stay in the United States is required to renew an Alaska license, permit or identification card.

In order to simplify the process, you will need to gather the necessary documents, calculate your required fee payment and pass certain exams before being able to obtain an Alaska drivers license.. Residents may obtain a learning license starting at 14 years of age upon passing a written knowledge test and fulfilling the application documentation requirements of identity, birth, Social Security Number and residency.. Alaska off-highway driver license applicants must be 18 years of age and older and follow the standard driving license guidelines of passing a vision test, providing proof of birth, Social Security Number and identity, and passing a written knowledge test via a proctor in their area.. For more information, visit Alaska New Drivers (Over 18) AK Driver's Study Guide and Driver's Practice Test Alaska residents completing a drivers licenses application are required to take a written drivers test..

- – Class M, M1, M3 licenses are issued to operators of motorcycles and motor scooters..
- Pass the Alcohol and Drug Awareness Knowledge Test (21 years of age and older)..

Alaska Drivers Licenses for Rural Residents Alaska drivers license applicants who reside in rural areas of the state may be eligible to apply for an Off-highway license by mail.

Below are the classes of driving license offered by the AK DMV:

- Non-commercial drivers license – Class D licenses are issued to drivers of standard vehicles for personal use.. Start simplifying your application process today By Mail Rather than get ahead with online assistance and services, some Alaska residents prefer to handle their DMV transactions via mail.. To help prepare yourself for the drivers exam, take a practice permit test. Drivers can complete a few different procedures by mail, but payment methods are restricted, and the transactions have inconvenient and lengthy turnaround times for results.. Drivers license classifications include non-commercial, motorcycle and commercial drivers licenses (CDL).. Via a DMV Office Certain transactions must be completed in person at an Alaska DMV office.. The learner can practice driving under the supervision of a licensed professional instructor.

The Off-highway license is designated for Alaska residents who mainly drive on roads not connected to the state highway system or roads with traffic volume that does not exceed 499 vehicles.. How to Apply for a New Driver's License in Alaska 1 In order to get a new Alaska drivers license, you need to complete a number of important steps when applying.. How to Apply for an Alaska Driver's License:

- Be at least 16 years of age
- Submit a signed application at an AK Division of Motor Vehicles office..
